17	(5) All patients admitted to the hospital shall be under the care of a state
18	registered and licensed practicing physician as defined by the laws of the state
19	of Vermont or advanced practice registered nurse (APRN) licensed pursuant to
20	26 V.S.A. chapter 23 or 28. A hospital shall grant APRNs licensed pursuant to

1	26 V.S.A. chapter 28, subchapter 3 all hospital staff privileges that the hospital
2	affords to physicians licensed pursuant to 26 V.S.A. chapter 23, including
3	hospital staff privileges to admit, treat, and discharge any patient for whom an
4	APRN is qualified to provide care. No provision of Vermont law or rule or
5	hospital bylaw or practice shall prohibit a qualified APRN from being
6	accorded clinical privileges or from being appointed to all categories of
7	hospital staff membership for which APRNs may provide services within their
8	authorized scope of practice.
