Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to extend from
July 1, 2018 to July 1, 2020 the sunset of the laws regulating the use of
automated license plate recognition (ALPR) systems and the retention and
disclosure of data collected by such systems.

An act relating to automated license plate recognition systems

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
