12 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

13 Sec. 1. 18 V.S.A. § 9374 is amended to read:

14 § 9374. BOARD MEMBERSHIP; AUTHORITY

15 (a)(1) On July 1, 2011, the Green Mountain Care Board is created and shall

16 consist of a chair and four members. The Chair and all of the members shall

17 be State employees and shall be exempt from the State classified system. The

18 Chair shall receive compensation equal to that of a Superior judge, and the

19 compensation for the remaining members shall be two-thirds of the amount

20 received by the Chair.



1       Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

2           This act shall take effect on passage and shall apply beginning with the first  
3       vacancy occurring on the Green Mountain Care Board on or after that date;  
4       provided, however, that it shall not apply to the vacancy of a member serving  
5       on the Board on the date of passage who seeks to serve more than one term.
