13	(a)(1) An agency shall establish a plan to designate positions within the
14	agency that are deemed eligible for telework. The agency shall provide
15	employees in eligible positions with a written explanation of their eligibility
16	for teleworking status which shall include the rationale for granting or denying
17	such status. Supervisors shall inform in writing employees who hold eligible
18	positions of the process for entering into a telework agreement with the State
19	and shall grant teleworking rights to all employees in eligible positions who
20	voluntarily apply.

1	(2) At no time shall any employee of the State of Vermont be required
2	to telework.
3	(b) The Commissioner of Human Resources shall report to the House and
4	Senate Committees on Government Operations on or before January 15, 2015
5	with a comprehensive report on the number of positions deemed eligible for
6	teleworking and shall propose a plan to increase the number of positions
7	eligible to at least 10 percent of all classified State positions by January 1,
8	<u>2017.</u>
9	(c) Employees who hold positions that are deemed to be ineligible for
10	teleworking shall have the right to appeal this designation before a panel
11	comprising equally representatives of the Department of Human Resources and
12	the exclusive bargaining agent representing State employees.
