Subject: Internal security and public safety; National Guard; Adjutant and
Inspector General; qualifications

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require that to
be eligible to become the Adjutant and Inspector General, an individual shall:

(1) have attained the rank of Colonel (O-6) or above;

(2) be a current member of the U.S. Army, the U.S. Air Force, the U.S.
Army Reserve, the U.S. Air Force Reserve, the Army National Guard, or the
Air National Guard, or be eligible to return to active service in the Army
National Guard or the Air National Guard;

(3) be a graduate of a Senior Service College; and

(4) be eligible for federal recognition as a Brigadier General (O-7) or
above.
