10	250's jurisdiction over recreational trails. It would state that Vermont Trail
11	System trails are for a public purpose. It would state that Act 250 jurisdiction
12	for these trails is determined by the amount of land physically disturbed. It
13	would clarify jurisdiction over other trails. It would exempt new trails
14	connecting to existing trails unless the new trail would trigger Act 250
15	jurisdiction on its own. It would allow jurisdiction over trails to be constructed
16	in phases to use individual segments for calculating Act 250 jurisdiction. It
17	would prohibit requests for Act 250 jurisdictional opinions for trails that have
18	been accepted into the Vermont Trail System.
