17	COLLECTIONS
18	(a) The eommissioner Commissioner may issue permits to a properly
19	accredited person or educational institution permitting the holder thereof to

1	collect birds, their nests and eggs, and fish and wild animals or parts thereof,
2	for public scientific research or educational purposes of the institution.
3	(b) In addition, the commissioner The Commissioner may issue a permit to
4	an individual which that allows the holder to collect fish and wild animals for
5	the purpose of using them as subjects of art or photography.
6	(c) The Commissioner may issue a permit to an individual that allows the
7	holder to collect birds or bird feathers for cultural or ceremonial purposes.

10	(a) Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter, after obtaining the
11	advice of the Endangered Species Committee, the Secretary may permit, under
12	such terms and conditions as the Secretary may prescribe by rule, any act
13	otherwise prohibited by this chapter if done for any of the following purposes:
14	scientific purposes; to enhance the propagation or survival of a species;
15	economic hardship; zoological exhibition; educational purposes; <u>cultural or</u>
16	ceremonial purposes, or special purposes consistent with the purposes of the
17	federal Endangered Species Act.
