15	As used in this title, unless the context or a specific definition requires a
16	different reading:

18	(7) "Candidate" means an individual who is constitutionally qualified to
19	hold a public office, which, pursuant to Vt. Const. Ch. I, Art. 8, includes the
20	requirement that the individual be a registered voter, and who has taken any

1	affirmative action to become a candidate for public office. A person takes
2	affirmative action by:
3	(A) accepting a contribution or making an expenditure directly or
4	indirectly;
5	(B) filing the requisite petition for one of the named positions or
6	being nominated by primary or otherwise; or
7	(C) publicly announcing that he or she seeks such a position.
