- development expenditures under 26 U.S.C. § 41(a) and which are made within
 this State.
- (b) Any unused credit available under subsection (a) of this section may becarried forward for up to 10 years.

1	(c) Each year, 50 percent of the credit available under this section shall be
2	<u>refundable.</u>
3	(d) Each year, on or before January 15, the Department of Taxes shall
4	publish a list containing the names of the taxpayers who have claimed a credit
