- 17 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

1	Sec. 1. COMMUNITY PROFILES
2	(a) The Agencies of Education and of Human Services shall resume the
3	compilation and annual publication of Community Profiles to measure
4	outcomes related to the well-being of Vermonters, such as the extent to which:
5	(1) pregnant women and newborns thrive;
6	(2) infants and children thrive;
7	(3) children are ready for school;
8	(4) children are successful in school;
9	(5) children live in stable and supported families;
10	(6) youths choose healthy behaviors; and
11	(7) youths successfully transition to adulthood.
12	(b) On or before February 15 of each year, the Secretaries of Human
13	Services and of Education shall file a written report with the General Assembly
14	regarding the status of outcomes on a State and local level to provide a
15	multidimensional view of the quality of life in each Vermont community.
