11	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require that
12	the electorate vote directly whether to approve a proposed supervisory union
13	budget, rather than including a proportionate share of the proposed budget as
14	an allocated expense within the total district budget. The supervisory union
15	would present its proposed budget as a separate article in the warning for the
16	district budget, expressing the sum in dollars and indicating the district's
17	proportionate share of the total budget. A supervisory union budget would be
18	established only if a majority of the commingled votes of the electorate of all
19	member districts were in favor of the budget.
