16	consumed in the State shall be renewable natural gas, increasing by an
17	additional five percent every January 1 thereafter until reaching 75 percent on
18	and after January 1, 2035.
19	(b) On or before January 1, 2023, all natural gas imported into the State
20	shall be certified as in compliance with the Independent Energy Standards
