10	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to establish a
11	pilot program to fund and operate an anaerobic digester for the management of
12	manure from multiple farms within a community or region. The pilot project
13	would allow all farms, regardless of size or location within a community,
14	access to the anaerobic digester for the management of manure. The
15	community anaerobic digester would eliminate the need for farmers to land-
16	apply manure, which would reduce agricultural runoff to waters and help the
17	State improve water quality in the watershed of the community anaerobic
18	digester. The pilot project would begin with the development of a scope of
19	work by a qualified university or nonprofit organization for the purpose of
20	identifying communities or regions of the State where it is technologically,
21	economically, and logistically feasible to site a community anaerobic digester.
