Subject: Municipal government; ordinance authority; tobacco prohibitions;  
persons younger than 21 years of age

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to authorize a  
town to adopt an ordinance that prohibits within the town:

(1) a person selling or providing tobacco products, tobacco substitutes,  
or tobacco paraphernalia to any person under 21 years of age; and

1           (2) a person under 21 years of age possessing, purchasing, or attempting  
2 to purchase tobacco products, tobacco substitutes, or tobacco paraphernalia.
