Subject: Conservation and development; air pollution; air quality impact
evaluation

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require a person proposing to emit a hazardous air contaminant to submit to the Secretary of Natural Resources (Secretary) an air quality impact evaluation if, after review of the toxicity of the air contaminant; the emission rate; the proximity of the emission source to residences or other population centers; and the emission dispersion characteristics at or near the source, the Secretary determines the proposed emission may exceed a hazardous ambient air standard set in the Agency of Natural Resources' Air Pollution Control Regulations. An air quality impact evaluation required by the Secretary shall demonstrate whether the actual emissions from the proposed discharge source, in conjunction with emissions from all other sources, will or will not cause or contribute to ambient air concentrations in excess of any hazardous ambient air standard set forth in the Agency of Natural Resources' Air Pollution Control Regulations. The Secretary shall determine whether any proposed emission
