8	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require a
9	person proposing to emit a hazardous air contaminant to submit to the
10	Secretary of Natural Resources (Secretary) an air quality impact evaluation if,
11	after review of the toxicity of the air contaminant; the emission rate; the
12	proximity of the emission source to residences or other population centers; and
13	the emission dispersion characteristics at or near the source, the Secretary
14	determines the proposed emission may exceed a hazardous ambient air
15	standard set in the Agency of Natural Resources' Air Pollution Control
16	Regulations. An air quality impact evaluation required by the Secretary shall
17	demonstrate whether the actual emissions from the proposed discharge source,
18	in conjunction with emissions from all other sources, will or will not cause or
19	contribute to ambient air concentrations in excess of any hazardous ambient air
20	standard set forth in the Agency of Natural Resources' Air Pollution Control
21	Regulations. The Secretary shall determine whether any proposed emission
