9 AN ACT RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT PROTECTION FOR10 VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS

- 11 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

- 14 (a) No employer shall discharge or in any manner discriminate against an
- 15 <u>employee for taking time off to perform emergency duty as a volunteer</u>
- 16 <u>firefighter.</u>
- 17 (b) Any employee who is discharged, threatened with discharge, demoted,
- 18 <u>suspended, or in any other manner discriminated against in the terms and</u>
- 19 <u>conditions of employment by his or her employer because the employee has</u>
- 20 <u>taken time off to perform emergency duty as a volunteer firefighter shall be</u>

1	entitled to reinstatement and reimbursement for lost wages and work benefits
2	caused by the acts of the employer. Any employer who willfully refuses to
3	rehire, promote, or otherwise restore an employee or former employee who has
4	been determined to be eligible for rehiring or promotion by a grievance
5	procedure, arbitration, or hearing authorized by law shall be imprisoned for not
6	more than two years or fined not more than \$1,000.00 or both.
7	(c) This section shall not apply to any public safety agency or provider of
8	emergency medical services when, as determined by the employer, the
9	employee's absence would hinder the availability of public safety or
10	emergency medical services.
11	(d) For purposes of this section, "firefighter" shall have the same meaning
