An act relating to extension of filing deadlines for homestead declarations and property tax adjustment claims

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. DEADLINE FOR CERTAIN 2008 HOMESTEAD DECLARATIONS AND PROPERTY TAX ADJUSTMENT CLAIMS

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a claimant residing in a town that sent its 2008 property tax bill on September 15, 2008 and who, within 21 days of such date, filed a declaration of homestead and a property tax adjustment claim for that homestead shall be entitled to any refund resulting from the corrected property classification and education property tax adjustment claim. The commissioner of taxes shall pay any refund due under this section with respect to an education property tax adjustment to a claimant who applies in writing to the commissioner on or before July 17, 2009. A refund due a claimant due to reclassification of property as homestead property under this section shall be refunded by the town.
