No. 38. An act relating to siting of electric generation plants.

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. LEGISLATIVE REVIEW; SITING POLICY COMMISSION

REPORT

During adjournment between the 2013 and 2014 sessions of the General Assembly:

(1) The House and Senate Committees on Natural Resources and Energy (the Committees) jointly shall review the report and recommendations of the Governor's Energy Generation Siting Policy Commission created by Executive Order No. 10-12 dated October 2, 2012; may consider any issue related to electric generation plants, including their development, siting, and operation; and may recommend legislation to the General Assembly concerning electric generation plants.

(2) The Committees shall meet jointly for the purposes of this section no more than six times at the call of the chairs. For attendance at these meetings, members of the Committees shall be entitled to compensation and reimbursement for expenses as provided in 2 V.S.A. § 406.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
