13	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
14	Sec. 1. LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE
15	The purpose of this act is to:
16	(1) provide for the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles to issue titles for
17	vehicles not required to be titled under Vermont law, if an owner requests a
18	title and satisfies certain conditions and the requirements of law governing
19	issuance of titles;

1	(2) expand the out-of-state market for, and thereby enhance the value of,
2	Vermont vehicles not previously eligible for titles under Department of Motor
3	Vehicles' practice; and
4	(3) authorize the State to pass along to the vehicle owner reasonable
5	costs associated with issuing a title for a vehicle not required to be titled under
6	Vermont law, up to \$100.00.

18	No certificate of title need be obtained for:
19	(1) a vehicle owned by the United States, unless it is registered in
20	this State;

1	(2) a vehicle owned by a manufacturer or dealer and held for sale, even
2	though incidentally moved on the highway or used for purposes of testing or
3	demonstration, or used by an educational institution approved by the Agency
4	of Education for driver training purposes, or a vehicle used by a manufacturer
5	solely for testing;
6	(3) a vehicle owned by a nonresident of this State and not required by
7	law to be registered in this State;
8	(4) a vehicle regularly engaged in the interstate transportation of persons
9	or property for which a currently effective certificate of title has been issued in
10	another state;
11	(5) a self-propelled wheel chair wheelchair or invalid tricycle;
12	(6) a motorcycle which has less than 300 cubic centimeters of engine

2	§ 2013. WHEN CERTIFICATE REQUIRED; ISSUANCE UPON REQUEST
3	(a)(1) Except as provided in section 2012 of this title, the provisions of this
4	chapter shall apply to and a title must be obtained for all motor vehicles at the
5	time of first registration or when a change of registration is required under the
6	provisions of section 321 of this title by reason of a sale for consideration,
7	except for vehicles that are more than 15 years old.
8	(2) In addition, a Vermont resident may apply at any time to the
9	Commissioner to obtain a certificate of title for a vehicle exempt from titling
10	under section 2012 of this title. The Commissioner shall issue the title if the
11	applicant pays the applicable fee and satisfies the provisions of this section

7	(iii) a copy of a previous Vermont registration; or
8	(iv) a notarized affidavit of ownership of the vehicle, which
9	must include:
10	(I) the date the applicant purchased or otherwise took
11	ownership of the vehicle;
12	(II) the name and address of the seller or transferor, if
13	known; and
14	(III) all evidence of past and present ownership, including bills
15	of sale or original receipts for major components of homebuilt vehicles.

17	(i) the applicant is a Vermont resident;
18	(ii) issuance of a title is reasonably necessary to facilitate the sale
19	of the vehicle out of state; and
20	(iii) the vehicle is not subject to any liens or encumbrances.

1	(C) Proof of Vermont residency as may be required by the
2	Commissioner.
3	(D) Assignment of a new vehicle identification number pursuant to
4	section 2003 of this title, if the vehicle does not have one.
5	(b) The Commissioner shall not require an application for a certificate of
6	title upon the renewal of the registration of a vehicle.
