15	become certified by the Vermont Criminal Justice Council in the use of
16	firearms for defensive purposes, appropriate use of force, reporting and record
17	keeping related to firearms, and personal liability for actions and conduct
18	related to firearms. The Commissioner and the Executive Director of the
19	Council shall develop the curriculum necessary to comply with this subsection.
20	A correctional officer who successfully completes the training requirements of

- 1 this subsection shall be permitted to carry a firearm while on duty and to
- 2 <u>employ it in a defensive capacity.</u>
