6	Sec. 2. MEMBERSHIP IN MULTIPLE NET METERING GROUPS
7	(a) In Public Service Board Rule 5.105 (Billing Standards and Procedures),
8	subdivision (B), the sentence "Individual customer accounts may be enrolled in
9	only one group net metering arrangement at one time." is struck and a new
10	provision is inserted in lieu thereof to read:
11	"Individual customer accounts may enroll in more than one group net
12	metering arrangement at one time. Any allocation of credits for energy
