(f)(1) The secretary shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 25 of this title to	
require hospitals and other health care facilities licensed in this state to ask	
individuals without health care coverage who request or receive services at the	
facility to fill out a provided application for the state's health programs,	
including Medicaid, Dr. Dynasaur, the Vermont health access plan, and	
Catamount Health. The rules shall permit an individual to refuse to complete	
the application and shall not impose a penalty for such refusal, but shall require	
facilities to request at each visit that the individual complete the application.	
(2) For purposes of this subsection, "health care facility" means all	
institutions, whether public or private, proprietary or nonprofit, which offer	
diagnosis, treatment, or inpatient or ambulatory care to two or more unrelated	
persons, and the buildings in which those services are offered. The term shall	
not apply to any facility operated by religious groups relying solely on spiritual	
means through prayer or healing.
