	(a) Before admitting an individual as an inpatient or providing services to
16	an individual in an emergency room, a designated member of the staff of a
17	hospital licensed pursuant to chapter 43 of this title shall provide the individual

18 with the opportunity to either:

1	(1) complete an anatomical gift form that complies with the provisions
2	of subchapter 1 of this chapter and has been approved by the commissioner of
3	health; or
4	(2) indicate by a check-box or similar means that the individual wishes
5	to opt out of completing the anatomical gift form.
6	(b) A hospital shall supply an anatomical gift form that complies with the
7	provisions of subchapter 1 of this title and has been approved by the
8	commissioner of health and shall provide the witnesses necessary to enable an
9	individual to complete the anatomical gift form.
10	(c)(1) In the case of an individual who lacks capacity at the time of the
11	hospital or emergency room admission, the designated staff shall follow up
12	with the individual at such time as the individual regains capacity in order to
13	provide the opportunity to complete the anatomical gift form or affirmatively
14	<u>opt out.</u>
15	(2) In the case of an individual who lacks capacity at the time of the
16	hospital or emergency room admission and fails to regain capacity while
17	admitted to the hospital, the requirements of this section shall be waived.
18	(d) Nothing in this section shall be deemed to require an individual to
19	complete an anatomical gift form or opt out of completing such form as a
20	condition of admission to a hospital or emergency room.
