18	(8) The Department shall consider all variances to its rules pertaining to
19	the educational requirements of a provider operating or employed at a

1	registered or licensed family child care home or a center-based child care and
2	preschool program.
3	Sec. 2. OUTREACH; CHILD CARE PROVIDERS
4	On or before September 1, 2018, the Department for Children and Families
5	shall post on its website guidance manuals to supplement the Department's
6	rules on registered and licensed family child care homes and center-based child
7	care and preschool programs. The Department shall also publish on its website
8	on a quarterly basis a newsletter pertaining to compliance with child care
9	providers' educational requirements.
10	Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE
11	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
