5	Subject: Municipal government; unorganized towns and gores
6	Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to: (1) allow the supervisor of an
7	unorganized town or gore to veto or revoke the appointment of an appraiser;
8	(2) require delinquent taxes to be immediately penalized and the penalties
9	deposited in the account of the unorganized town or gore; and (3) require all
10	moneys collected by the supervisors to be deposited in the account of the
11	unorganized town or gore.

14	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
15	Sec. 1. 24 V.S.A. § 1401 is amended to read:
16	§ 1401. APPRAISERS; APPOINTMENT
17	Subject to the approval of the governor, the director of the division of
18	property valuation and review shall appoint biennially on the first Tuesday of
19	March a board of three appraisers for the unorganized towns and gores in each
20	county, with power to revoke any such appointment and to fill any vacancy in

1	such on the board. The supervisor of an unorganized town or gore shall have
2	the right to:
3	(1) veto an appointment and request another appointment; or
4	(2) revoke an appointment and request a replacement appraiser at any
5	time during the appraiser's term.

7	§ 1229. SUPERVISORS FOR UNORGANIZED TOWNS AND GORES
8	A supervisor for unorganized towns and gores shall receive \$15.00 a day for
9	time actually spent in the performance of his or her duties, except for his or her
10	services as collector of taxes. On all taxes collected after the expiration of 90
11	days from mailing of his or her tax notice, such supervisor shall be allowed to
12	tax and collect from the taxpayer a commission of eight percent in the amount
13	of the tax, which commission shall be paid into the state treasury as provided
14	in section 4967 of this title. All taxes that are late shall be charged an
15	immediate penalty of eight percent plus one percent per month interest, all of
16	which shall be deposited in the unorganized town's or gore's account.

18	§ 4967. TRANSMISSION OF TAXES TO DIRECTOR
19	All moneys received by supervisors in the collection of taxes or otherwise

in the performance of their official duties, except fees, shall be paid by them to

the director quarterly, deposited in the unorganized town's or gore's account

- on the first Tuesday in February, May, August, and November. Such director
- 2 shall keep separate accounts of the moneys so received by him or her from the
- 3 respective supervisors.
