4	$(\mathbf{D})(\mathbf{iv})$ any individual employed in the activities of a public
5	supported nonprofit organization, except laundry employees, nurses' aides, or

7	(E)(v) any individual employed in a bona fide executive,
8	administrative, or professional capacity;
9	(F)(vi) any individual making home deliveries of newspapers or

13	(H)(ix) students working during all or any part of the school year or
