6 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to continue to
7 permit the State Lottery Commission to adopt rules permitting the sale of
8 lottery products in establishments that also hold first-class and first- and
9 third-class licenses to sell alcoholic beverages.

10 An act relating to the sale of lottery products

11 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

12 Sec. 1. REPEAL

13 2015 Acts and Resolves No. 57, Sec. 97 (amending the Lottery
14 Commission's rulemaking authority with respect to lottery product sales
15 locations) is repealed.

16 Sec. 2. REPEAL

17 2015 Acts and Resolves No. 57, Sec. 99(15) (effective date for amendment
18 to the Lottery Commission's rulemaking authority with respect to lottery
19 product sales locations) is repealed.

1 Sec. 3. 31 V.S.A. § 654 is amended to read:

2 § 654. POWERS AND DUTIES

3 The Commission shall adopt rules pursuant to 3 V.S.A. chapter 25,
4 governing the establishment and operation of the State Lottery. The rules may
5 include the following:

7 (7) ~~Ticket~~ Lottery product sales locations, which may include ~~state~~ State
8 liquor stores and liquor agencies; private business establishments; fraternal,
9 religious, and volunteer organizations; town clerks' offices; and ~~state~~ State
10 fairs, race tracks and other sporting arenas;

12 Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE DATES

13 (a) This section and Secs. 1 and 2 shall take effect on passage.

14 (b) Sec. 3 shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
