12	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

15	A person who desires to register to vote may apply in any of the
16	following ways:
17	(1) Simultaneously with his or her application for, or renewal of, a
18	motor vehicle driver's license as provided in section 2145a of this title.
19	(2) By completing a voter registration application at a voter
20	registration agency.

1	(3) By the person who desires to register delivering, during regular
2	hours, or mailing a completed application form to the office of the clerk of the
3	town in which the applicant claims to be a resident. If the completed
4	application form is delivered or mailed by a person other than the person who
5	desires to register, the form shall be delivered to or received by the office of
6	the clerk of the town in which the applicant claims to be a resident within
7	seven days of the date the application form was signed by the voter.

11	(a) An application for, or renewal of, a motor vehicle driver's license shall
12	serve as a simultaneous application to register to vote unless the applicant
13	declines to sign the voter registration portion of the application.
14	(b) The voter registration portion of the motor vehicle driver's license
15	application shall provide and request the information required to be provided
16	under section 2145 of this title and shall be in the form approved by the
17	secretary of state Secretary of State.
18	(c) An application for voter registration under this section shall update any
19	previous voter registration by the applicant. Any change of address form
20	submitted to the department of motor vehicles Department of Motor Vehicles
21	in connection with an application for a motor vehicle driver's license shall

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serve to update voter registration information previously provided by the voter,
unless the voter states on the form that the change of address is not for voter
