1 On page 20, after line 24, insert the following:

2 "(7) The adoption of ordinances, amendments to comprehensive
3 plans, amendments to development regulations, and other nonproject
4 actions taken by a county or city to include in its comprehensive
5 plan a climate change and resiliency element or the requirements to
6 the land use element, capital facilities element, parks and
7 recreation element, transportation element, and utilities element
8 established by this act are not subject to administrative or judicial
9 appeal to the growth management hearings board under RCW 36.70A.280,
10 except that the actions taken by a county or city to include the
11 requirements of this section may be subject to administrative or
12 judicial appeal if at least 10 years has commenced since the
13 jurisdiction's scheduled update of its comprehensive plan as
14 established by RCW 36.70A.130(5)."

15 On page 25, after line 8, insert the following:

16 "(c) The provisions in this subsection take effect as follows:

17 (i) On December 31, 2034, for King, Kitsap, Pierce, and Snohomish
18 counties and the cities within those counties;

19 (ii) On June 30, 2035, for Clallam, Clark, Island, Jefferson,
20 Lewis, Mason, San Juan, Skagit, Thurston, and Whatcom counties and
21 the cities within those counties;

22 (iii) On June 30, 2036, for Benton, Chelan, Cowlitz, Douglas,
23 Franklin, Kittitas, Skamania, Spokane, Walla Walla, and Yakima
24 counties and the cities within those counties; and

25 (iv) On June 30, 2037, for Adams, Asotin, Columbia, Ferry,
26 Garfield, Grant, Grays Harbor, Klickitat, Lincoln, Okanogan, Pacific,
27 Pend Oreille, Stevens, Wahkiakum, and Whitman counties and the cities
28 within those counties."

EFFECT: Provides that the adoption of ordinances, amendments to comprehensive plans, amendments to development regulations, and other nonproject actions taken by a county or city to implement the climate change and resiliency element as well as the elements amended by this act are not subject to administrative or judicial review to the

growth management hearings board until the jurisdiction's next comprehensive plan update. Provides that Commerce's final decision to approve or reject a proposed greenhouse gas emissions reduction subelement or amendment by a local government takes effect after the jurisdiction's next comprehensive plan update.

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
