EFFECT: Requires the department of ecology, as a condition of entering into a linkage agreement, to determine that the linkage agreement will not result in allowance prices that are higher than those that occurred during a single allowance auction that occurred in calendar year 2023. Requires this determination to be based on an economic analysis that forecasts potential linking jurisdiction allowance prices under current program stringency through 2030 and under a model that assumes program stringency requirements are increased through 2030 in a manner consistent with current scoping plans, rule-making proposals, or rules or potential linking jurisdictions. Requires linkage agreements to provide an automatic process for Washington's withdrawal from a linkage agreement if the allowance prices exceed those that occurred during a single allowance auction that occurred in calendar year 2023.

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
