AN ACT Relating to creating the offense of unlawful branding of another person; amending RCW 9.94A.515 and 9A.04.080; adding a new section to chapter 9A.40 RCW; creating a new section; and prescribing penalties.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

The legislature finds that crimes and 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. 7 threats against persons because of their race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, 8 gender expression or identity, mental, physical, or sensory disabilities, or 9 10 vulnerability to trafficking and commercial sexual exploitation are 11 serious and have a lifetime impact on the targeted victims. The 12 legislature further finds that the causes of commercial sexual exploitation are rooted in the attitudes, beliefs, and behaviors that 13 contribute to the demand for and growth of this criminal industry. 14 15 legislature recognizes that traffickers around the The world 16 frequently prey on individuals who are poor, vulnerable, living in an 17 unsafe or unstable situation, or are in search of a better life. 18 Trafficking victims are deceived by false promises of love, wealth, 19 or a stable life and are lured or forced into situations where they 20 are made to engage in sexual exploitation or other work under deplorable conditions with little or no pay. The legislature finds 21

that the state has a compelling interest in preventing crimes and 1 threats motivated by an intent to exert power and control over others 2 furtherance of human trafficking and commercial 3 in sexual exploitation and such interest includes preventing the forcing of 4 victims to have their body marked for the purpose of identifying and 5 6 tracking the person for ownership as part of a plan or scheme to 7 engage in human trafficking or sexual exploitation. This practice causes a harm to victims that is most appropriately punished as 8 branding instead of assault. The seriousness level assigned to the 9 crime of "branding" herein also takes into account the likelihood 10 11 that many acts that would constitute that crime would otherwise be used to support aggravating circumstances listed in RCW 9.94A.537. 12

13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 9A.40 14 RCW to read as follows:

15 (1) A person is guilty of unlawful branding of another person if 16 he or she knowingly:

(a) Marks another person's body with a subdermal implant, tattoo, or body art, with the knowledge that the mark is intended to be used to track the person or mark the person for ownership as part of a plan or scheme to engage in trafficking of the person under RCW 9A.40.100 or promoting prostitution of the person under RCW 9A.88.070 or 9A.88.080; or

(b) Uses force, fraud, or coercion to cause a person to have his or her body marked with a subdermal implant, tattoo, or body art, for the purpose of tracking the person or marking the person for ownership as part of a plan or scheme to engage in trafficking of the person under RCW 9A.40.100 or promoting prostitution of the person under RCW 9A.88.070 or 9A.88.080.

(2) Unlawful branding of another person is a class B felony.

30 (3) For the purposes of this section:

31 (a) "Body art" has the same meaning as provided in RCW 32 18.300.010.

33 (b) "Coercion" has the same meaning as provided in RCW 9A.36.070.

34 (c) "Tattoo" means an indelible mark made by tattooing, as 35 defined in RCW 18.300.010.

(f) The following offenses may not be prosecuted more than five years after its commission: Any class C felony under chapter 74.09, 82.36, or 82.38 RCW.

(g) Bigamy may not be prosecuted more than three years after the time specified in RCW 9A.64.010.

(h) A violation of RCW 9A.56.030 may not be prosecuted more than three years after the discovery of the offense when the victim is a tax exempt corporation under 26 U.S.C. Sec. 501(c)(3).

(i) No other felony may be prosecuted more than three years after its commission; except that in a prosecution under RCW 9A.44.115, if the person who was viewed, photographed, or filmed did not realize at the time that he or she was being viewed, photographed, or filmed, the prosecution must be commenced within two years of the time the person who was viewed or in the photograph or film first learns that he or she was viewed, photographed, or filmed.

33 (j) No gross misdemeanor may be prosecuted more than two years 34 after its commission.

35 (k) No misdemeanor may be prosecuted more than one year after its 36 commission.
