3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 70.05.180 and 1999 c 391 s 2 are each amended to 5 read as follows:

6 A person rendering emergency care or transportation, commonly 7 known as a "Good Samaritan," as described in RCW 4.24.300 and 4.24.310, may request and receive appropriate infectious disease 8 testing free of charge from the local health department of the county 9 of her or his residence, if((:(1))) while rendering emergency care 10 11 she or he came into contact with bodily fluids((; and (2) she or he 12 does not have health insurance that covers the testing)). Testing of the source patient may be performed in order to guide postexposure 13 14 prophylaxis treatment of the good samaritan. If the exchange of bodily fluids significantly increases the odds of the good samaritan 15 16 being exposed to a deadly infectious disease, testing of the source 17 patient may be performed without the consent of the source patient. Source patient testing may be requested and received free of charge 18 from the local health department of the county of his or her 19 20 residence. Nothing in this section requires a local health department

1 to provide health care services beyond testing. The department shall 2 adopt rules implementing this section.

3 The information obtained from infectious disease testing is 4 subject to statutory confidentiality provisions, including those of 5 chapters 70.24 and 70.05 RCW.
