1 AN ACT Relating to the distribution of shared game lottery 2 proceeds to the Washington opportunity pathways account; and amending 3 RCW 67.70.340.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 67.70.340 and 2012 1st sp.s. c 10 s 6 are each 6 amended to read as follows:

7 ((The legislature recognizes that creating a shared game (1)8 lottery could result in less revenue being raised by the existing state lottery ticket sales. The legislature further recognizes that 9 10 the fund most impacted by this potential event is the Washington 11 opportunity pathways account. Therefore, it is the intent of the 12 legislature to use some of the proceeds from the shared game lottery 13 to make up the difference that the potential state lottery revenue 14 loss would have on the Washington opportunity pathways account. The 15 legislature further intends to use some of the proceeds from the shared game lottery to fund programs and services related to problem 16 and pathological gambling. 17

18 (2) The Washington opportunity pathways account is expected to 19 receive one hundred two million dollars annually from state lottery 20 games other than the shared game lottery. For fiscal year 2011 and 21 thereafter, if the amount of lottery revenues earmarked for the Washington opportunity pathways account is less than one hundred two million dollars, the commission, after making the transfer required under subsection (3) of this section, must transfer sufficient moneys from revenues derived from the shared game lottery into the Washington opportunity pathways account to bring the total revenue up to one hundred two million dollars.

(3))(a) The commission shall transfer, from revenue derived from 7 the shared game lottery, to the problem gambling account created in 8 RCW ((43.20A.892)) 41.05.751, an amount equal to the percentage 9 specified in (b) of this subsection of net receipts. For purposes of 10 this subsection, "net receipts" means the difference between (i) 11 12 revenue received from the sale of lottery tickets or shares and revenue received from the sale of shared game lottery tickets or 13 shares; and (ii) the sum of payments made to winners. 14

15 (b) In fiscal year 2006, the percentage to be transferred to the 16 problem gambling account is one-tenth of one percent. In fiscal year 17 2007 and subsequent fiscal years, the percentage to be transferred to 18 the problem gambling account is thirteen one-hundredths of one 19 percent.

20 (((4) The commission shall transfer the remaining net revenues, 21 if any, derived from the shared game lottery "Powerball" authorized 22 in RCW 67.70.044(1) after the transfers pursuant to this section into 23 the state general fund for support for the program of basic education 24 under RCW 28A.150.200.

25 (5))) (2) The remaining net revenues((, if any,)) in the shared 26 game lottery account after the transfers pursuant to ((this section)) 27 subsection (1) of this section shall be deposited into the Washington 28 opportunity pathways account.

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
