1 AN ACT Relating to assisting Washington student athletes by 2 prioritizing athletic scholarship funding; adding a new section to 3 chapter 28B.10 RCW; creating a new section; and providing an 4 expiration date.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature recognizes that due to the 7 pandemic caused by COVID-19, Washington high school athletes have not been able to participate in athletic programs. This has resulted in a 8 reduced opportunity to showcase athletic talents that help these 9 10 students get recruited by and receive athletic scholarships from 11 universities and colleges. The legislature therefore intends to 12 support Washington athletes by requiring the state's public four-year 13 institutions of higher education to devote a portion of athletic scholarship funding to Washington athletes. 14

15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 28B.10 16 RCW to read as follows:

(1) Beginning with the 2022-23 academic year and until the 2025-26 academic year, the public four-year institutions of higher education must reserve at least 50 percent of available athletic scholarship funding for newly recruited student athletes graduating 1 from Washington public high schools, Washington private high schools

2 approved under chapter 28A.195 RCW, or Washington community or

3 technical colleges.

4 (2) This section expires December 31, 2026.
