- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 50.04 6 RCW to read as follows:
- The term "employment" does not include services performed by individuals age fourteen to twenty-two years. This exclusion applies
- 9 only to the determination of whether state unemployment tax premiums
- 10 are owed pursuant to chapter 50.24 RCW. It does not affect
- 11 eligibility for unemployment insurance benefits for workers age
- 12 fourteen to twenty-two years under chapter 50.20 RCW.
- 13 Sec. 2. If any part of this act is found to be in NEW SECTION. conflict with federal requirements that are a prescribed condition to 14 15 the allocation of federal funds to the state or the eligibility of 16 employers in this state for federal unemployment tax credits, the 17 conflicting part of this act is inoperative solely to the extent of the conflict, and the finding or determination does not affect the 18 operation of the remainder of this act. Rules adopted under this act 19
- 20 must meet federal requirements that are a necessary condition to the
