- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 49.46
- 6 RCW to read as follows:
- Beginning July 1, 2020, no state agency may employ an individual
- 8 to work under a special certificate issued under RCW 49.12.110 and
- 9 49.46.060 for the employment of individuals with disabilities at less
- 10 than the minimum wage. Any special certificate issued by the director
- 11 to a state agency for the employment of an individual with a
- 12 disability at less than minimum wage must expire by June 30, 2020.
- 13 For the purposes of this section, "state agency" means any office,
- 14 department, commission, or other unit of state government.
