- 1 AN ACT Relating to the transition of medicaid enrollees to
- 2 skilled nursing facility care; adding a new section to chapter 74.09
- 3 RCW; and providing an expiration date.

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- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 74.09 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) The authority and the department of social and health

services shall convene a work group consisting of representatives of

- 9 skilled nursing facilities, hospitals, and managed health care
- 10 systems. The work group shall identify barriers that may prevent
- 11 skilled nursing facilities from accepting and admitting enrollees
- 12 from acute care hospitals in a timely and appropriate manner. The
- 13 work group shall consider what additional resources are needed to
- 14 allow for faster transfers of enrollees, including those with complex
- 15 needs. By December 1, 2017, the authority shall report the work group
- 16 findings to the governor and the committees of the legislature with
- 17 jurisdiction over health care matters.
- 18 (2) This section expires June 30, 2018.

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
