AN ACT Relating to creating United States Naval Academy special license plates; amending RCW 43.60A.140; reenacting and amending RCW 46.17.220, 46.18.200, and 46.68.425; adding a new section to chapter 46.04 RCW; and providing an effective date.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 Sec. 1. RCW 46.17.220 and 2022 c 239 s 1 and 2022 c 117 s 1 are 7 each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

8 In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 9 application for a vehicle registration in chapter 46.16A RCW, the 10 holder of a special license plate shall pay the appropriate special 11 license plate fee as listed in this section.

33 department:

1 (a) May be issued in lieu of standard issue or personalized 2 license plates for vehicles required to display one and two license 3 plates unless otherwise specified; 4 (b) Must be issued under terms and conditions established by the 5 department; 6 (c) Must not be issued for vehicles registered under chapter 7 46.87 RCW; and (d) Must display a symbol or artwork approved by the department. 8 9 (2) The department approves and shall issue the following special license plates, subject to subsection (5) of this section: 10 11 LICENSE PLATE DESCRIPTION, SYMBOL, OR 12 ARTWORK 13 4-H Displays the "4-H" logo. 14 Armed forces collection Recognizes the contribution of 15 veterans, active duty military 16 personnel, reservists, and 17 members of the national guard, 18 and includes six separate designs, 19 each containing a symbol 20 representing a different branch of 21 the armed forces to include army, 22 navy, air force, marine corps, 23 coast guard, and national guard. 24 Displays a pink ribbon Breast cancer awareness 25 symbolizing breast cancer 26 awareness. 27 Endangered wildlife Displays a symbol or artwork 28 symbolizing endangered wildlife 29 in Washington state. 30 Fred Hutch Displays the Fred Hutch logo. 31 Gonzaga University alumni Recognizes the Gonzaga 32 association University alumni association. 33 Helping kids speak Recognizes an organization that 34 supports programs that provide 35 no-cost speech pathology 36 programs to children.

(3) Applicants for initial and renewal professional firefighters
 and paramedics special license plates must show proof of eligibility
 by providing a certificate of current membership from the Washington
 state council of firefighters.

26 (4) Applicants for initial volunteer firefighters special license 27 plates must (a) have been a volunteer firefighter for at least ((ten)) 10 years or be a volunteer firefighter for one or more years 28 29 and (b) have documentation of service from the district of the 30 appropriate fire service. If the volunteer firefighter leaves 31 firefighting service before ((ten)) 10 years of service have been 32 completed, the volunteer firefighter shall surrender the license 33 plates to the department on the registration renewal date. If the volunteer firefighter stays in service for at least ((ten)) 10 years 34 35 and then leaves, the license plate may be retained by the former 36 volunteer firefighter and as long as the license plate is retained 37 for use the person will continue to pay the future registration renewals. A qualifying volunteer firefighter may have no more than 38

one set of license plates per vehicle, and a maximum of two sets per applicant, for their personal vehicles. If the volunteer firefighter is convicted of a violation of RCW 46.61.502 or a felony, the license plates must be surrendered upon conviction.

5 (5) The department shall not issue the Seattle NHL hockey special 6 license plate until the department receives signature sheets 7 satisfying the requirements identified in RCW 46.18.110(2)(f).

8 Sec. 3. RCW 46.68.425 and 2016 c 31 s 3 and 2016 c 30 s 4 are 9 each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

10 (1) The department shall:

11 (a) Collect special license plate fees established under RCW
12 46.17.220;

(b) Deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars for initial issue and two dollars for renewal issue for administration and collection expenses incurred by it; and

16 (c) Remit the remaining proceeds to the custody of the state 17 treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report.

18 (2) The state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor 19 vehicle fund until the department determines that the state has been 20 reimbursed for the cost of implementing the special license plate. 21 Upon determination by the department that the state has been 22 reimbursed, the state treasurer shall credit the remaining special 23 license plate fees to the following accounts by special license plate 24 type:

7 Sec. 4. RCW 43.60A.140 and 2019 c 415 s 965 are each amended to 8 read as follows:

9 (1) The veterans stewardship account is created in the custody of 10 state treasurer. Disbursements of funds must be the on the 11 authorization of the director or the director's designee, and only for the purposes stated in subsection (4) of this section. In order 12 13 to maintain an effective expenditure and revenue control, funds are 14 subject in all respects to chapter 43.88 RCW, but no appropriation is 15 required to permit expenditure of the funds.

16 (2)The department may request and accept nondedicated 17 contributions, grants, or gifts in cash or otherwise, including funds 18 generated by the issuance of the armed forces license plate 19 collection and the United States Naval Academy license plate under 20 chapter 46.18 RCW.

(3) All receipts from the sale of armed forces license plates,
 <u>United States Naval Academy license plates</u>, and Purple Heart license
 plates as required under RCW 46.68.425(2) must be deposited into the
 veterans stewardship account.

25 (4) All moneys deposited into the veterans stewardship account 26 must be used by the department for activities that benefit veterans or their families, including but not limited to, providing programs 27 28 and services for homeless veterans; establishing memorials honoring 29 veterans; and maintaining a future state veterans' cemetery. Funds 30 from the account may not be used to supplant existing funds received 31 by the department. For the 2019-2021 fiscal biennium, moneys 32 deposited into the veterans stewardship account may be used for the 33 department's traumatic brain injury program.

34 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 5. A new section is added to chapter 46.04 35 RCW to read as follows: "United States Naval Academy license plates" mean special license plates issued under RCW 46.18.200 that display a design related to the United States Naval Academy.

4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 6. This act takes effect November 1, 2023.
