- 1 AN ACT Relating to requiring the department of revenue to submit
- 2 a sales and use tax products status report; and creating new
- 3 sections.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that there are
- 6 increasing inconsistencies and complexities in the application of
- 7 sales and use taxes in the state. The application of these taxes does
- 8 not take into account the emergence of new products or the changing
- 9 needs of the population. The addition of new exemptions or new taxes
- 10 without clear policy objectives results in confusion, inequality, and
- 11 tax policies that lack purpose or consistency.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The department of revenue must submit a
- 13 report to the fiscal committees of the legislature that includes a
- 14 complete inventory of products and services that are subject to state
- 15 sales and use taxes and of products and services that are exempt from
- 16 state sales and use taxes. For products and services that are exempt,
- 17 the report must indicate whether there is a record of intent from the

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- 1 legislation that exempted the item and describe the intent in
- 2 instances where it is available. The report is due January 8, 2018.

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
