- 1 AN ACT Relating to assessing patient anxiety; adding a new
- 2 section to chapter 70.54 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that in 2017 one
- 5 thousand two hundred ninety-two Washingtonians died by suicide. The
- 6 legislature finds that many individuals who attempt suicide or die by
- 7 suicide have an undiagnosed mental health condition. The legislature
- 8 recognizes that a person's unassessed mental health or anxiety level
- 9 can lead to severe medical emergencies or even death. The legislature
- 10 further recognizes that health care professionals are in a unique
- 11 position to notice depression, anxiety, and suicide warning signs in
- 12 their patients and intervene early.
- 13 Therefore, the legislature intends to increase screening for
- 14 anxiety to allow for possible early intervention.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 70.54
- 16 RCW to read as follows:
- 17 Beginning January 1, 2020, a patient's anxiety level must be
- 18 assessed by a health care provider upon the patient's intake at a
- 19 hospital, urgent care center, or primary care clinic.

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(2) The health care provider must use either the generalized anxiety disorder 2-item or generalized anxiety disorder 7-item assessment tool to assess the patient's anxiety.

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
