## HOUSE BILL 1966

- AN ACT Relating to adding wheelchair users to the types of individuals for whom drivers must take additional precautions; amending RCW 70.84.040; and providing an effective date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 70.84.040 and 1997 c 271 s 20 are each amended to read 6 as follows:

The driver of a vehicle approaching a totally or partially blind 7 pedestrian who is carrying a cane predominantly white in color (with or 8 9 without a red tip), a totally or partially blind or hearing impaired pedestrian using a dog quide, ((or an otherwise physically disabled)) 10 a person with physical disabilities using a service animal, or a person 11 with a disability using a wheelchair or a power wheelchair as defined 12 in RCW 46.04.415 shall take all necessary precautions to avoid injury 13 14 to such pedestrian or wheelchair user. Any driver who fails to take 15 such precaution shall be liable in damages for any injury caused such 16 pedestrian or wheelchair user. It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to drive into or upon any crosswalk while there is on 17 18 such crosswalk( $(\tau)$ ) such pedestrian( $(\tau)$ ) or wheelchair user crossing or 19 attempting to cross the roadway, if such pedestrian or wheelchair user

- 1 is using a white cane, using a dog guide, ((or)) using a service
- 2 animal, or using a wheelchair or a power wheelchair as defined in RCW
- 3 46.04.415. The failure of any such pedestrian or wheelchair user so to
- 4 signal shall not deprive him or her of the right-of-way accorded him or
- 5 <u>her</u> by other laws.
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act takes effect August 1, 2009.
