## HOUSE BILL 2176

State of Washington 68th Legislature 2024 Regular Session

AN ACT Relating to improving access to patient care by increasing preventive dental care; amending RCW 18.260.090; and adding new sections to chapter 18.260 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 18.260 6 RCW to read as follows:

7 The commission shall issue a license to practice as a preventive 8 dental assistant to any applicant who:

9 (1) Pays any applicable fees as established by the secretary in 10 accordance with RCW 43.70.110 and 43.70.250;

(2) Submits, on forms provided by the secretary, the applicant's name, address, and other applicable information as determined by the secretary; and

14 (3) Demonstrates competency as a preventive dental assistant as15 determined by the commission.

16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 18.260 17 RCW to read as follows:

18 (1) The commission shall adopt rules relating to the scope of 19 preventive dental assistant services that may be performed by

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1 preventive dental assistants under the supervision of a licensed 2 dentist.

3 (2) The scope of preventive dental assistant services that the 4 commission identifies in subsection (1) of this section must include:

5 (a) Dental assisting services that a dental assistant may perform 6 under the supervision of a licensed dentist;

7 (b) Dental prophylaxis for patients in a healthy oral state as 8 defined by the commission; and

9 (c) Periodontal probing after initial probing by a dentist or 10 dental hygienist and diagnosis by a dentist.

(3) A dentist may not assign a preventive dental assistant to perform services until the preventive dental assistant has demonstrated skills necessary to competently perform all assigned duties and responsibilities.

15 Sec. 3. RCW 18.260.090 and 2007 c 269 s 8 are each amended to 16 read as follows:

17 <u>(1)</u> The commission shall issue an initial credential or renewal 18 credential to an applicant who has met the requirements for a 19 credential or deny an initial credential or renewal credential based 20 upon failure to meet the requirements for a credential or 21 unprofessional conduct or impairment governed by chapter 18.130 RCW.

22 (2) The commission may adopt rules for renewal requirements for a 23 credential, including continuing education requirements, for 24 preventive dental assistants and expanded function dental auxiliary 25 licenses.

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
