- 1 AN ACT Relating to fire trailer vehicle registration and license
- 2 plates; adding a new section to chapter 46.04 RCW; adding a new
- 3 section to chapter 46.16A RCW; and providing an effective date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.04 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 "Fire trailer" means a commercial trailer that is used only for
- 8 wildfire response as required by state and federal regulations, is
- 9 only transported between storage and job sites, and is equipped with
- 10 a water tank designed for firefighting purposes.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 46.16A RCW to read as follows:
- 13 (1) A fire trailer may be issued a permanent license plate and
- 14 registration. To be eligible to receive a permanent license plate and
- 15 registration, the registered owner of the fire trailer must:
- 16 (a) Apply for a permanent registration with the department,
- 17 county auditor or other agent, or subagent appointed by the director;

- 1 (b) Pay the initial commercial trailer registration fee required 2 under RCW 46.17.350(1)(c) in addition to any other fees and taxes due 3 by law.
- 4 (2) A fire trailer with a permanent registration under this 5 section is exempt from annual registration renewal under RCW 6 46.16A.110.
- 7 (3) The permanent registration under this section expires when 8 the fire trailer changes ownership, is permanently removed from the 9 state, or is otherwise disposed of.
- 10 (4) The permanent license plate and registration authorized in subsection (1) of this section may not be issued to fire trailers that haul logs.
- 13 (5) The department may adopt rules to implement this section.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act takes effect October 1, 2020.
