- **Sec. 1.** RCW 9.41.330 and 2013 c 183 s 3 are each amended to read 5 6 as follows:
- 7 $((\frac{1}{1}))$ On or after $(\frac{3uly}{28}, \frac{2013}{2013})$ the effective date of this section, whenever a defendant in this state is convicted of a felony 8 firearm offense or found not guilty by reason of insanity of any 9 10 felony firearm offense, the court ((must consider whether to)) shall 11 impose a requirement that the person comply with the registration requirements of RCW 9.41.333 ((and may, in its discretion, impose 12
- 13 such a requirement.
- 14 (2) In determining whether to require the person to register, the 15 court shall consider all relevant factors including, but not limited 16 to:
- 17 (a) The person's criminal history;
- 18 (b) Whether the person has previously been found not quilty by 19 reason of insanity of any offense in this state or elsewhere; and
