1 AN ACT Relating to veterans' scoring criteria; and amending RCW 2 41.04.010.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 41.04.010 and 2009 c 248 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

(1) In all competitive examinations, unless otherwise provided in б 7 this section, to determine the qualifications of applicants for public offices, positions, or employment, either the state, and all of its 8 9 political subdivisions and all municipal corporations, or private 10 companies or agencies contracted with by the state to give the 11 competitive examinations shall give a scoring criteria status to all veterans as defined in RCW 41.04.007, by adding to the passing mark, 12 13 grade or rating only, based upon a possible rating of one hundred 14 points as perfect a percentage in accordance with the following:

15 (((1))) (a) Ten percent to a veteran who served during a period of 16 war or in an armed conflict as defined in RCW 41.04.005 ((and does not 17 receive military retirement)). The percentage shall be added to the 18 passing mark, grade, or rating of competitive examinations until the

veteran's first appointment. The percentage shall not be utilized in promotional examinations;

3 (((2))) (b) Five percent to a veteran who did not serve during a 4 period of war or in an armed conflict as defined in RCW 41.04.005 ((or 5 is receiving military retirement)). The percentage shall be added to 6 the passing mark, grade, or rating of competitive examinations until 7 the veteran's first appointment. The percentage shall not be utilized 8 in promotional examinations;

9 (((3))) <u>(c)</u> Five percent to a veteran who was called to active 10 military service from employment with the state or any of its political 11 subdivisions or municipal corporations. The percentage shall be added 12 to promotional examinations until the first promotion only((+)).

13 (((4))) <u>(2)</u> All veterans' scoring criteria may be claimed upon 14 release from active military service.
