- $\underline{\text{NEW SECTION.}}$ Sec. 1. (1) The legislature recognizes that the
- 6 high cost of quality child care places a heavy burden on Washington's
- 7 poorest families. The legislature further acknowledges the
- 8 administrative burden unnecessary regulations place on child care
- 9 providers and the families they serve. The legislature finds that
- 10 under current rule, child care providers may not serve five year olds
- 11 attending school in the same group as five year olds not attending
- 12 school.
- 13 (2) The legislature intends to require the department of early
- 14 learning to allow five year olds, regardless of whether they attend
- 15 elementary school or not, to be placed in the same group. The
- 16 legislature further intends to streamline the delivery of services to
- 17 children while continuing to protect their safety and well-being.
- 18 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 43.215
- 19 RCW to read as follows:

p. 1 HB 2511

(1) The department may not adopt rules that prohibit licensed child care centers from serving children age sixty months through five years, whether attending elementary school or not, in a mixed group or classroom.
