

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 2019-4608, by Representative Thai

1 WHEREAS, On this fifth day of February in 2019, the people of  
2 Washington join the celebration of the Lunar New Year, which is  
3 observed in many Asian cultures around the world; and

4 WHEREAS, Asian Americans are an integral component of the diverse  
5 fabric of Washington state, and are among the fastest-growing  
6 populations in Washington; and

7 WHEREAS, The Lunar New Year is an important cultural event when  
8 Asian Americans celebrate their customs and traditions with  
9 traditional foods, costumes, and spiritual practices; and

10 WHEREAS, Festivals marking the Lunar New Year take place each  
11 year in communities throughout our state, providing opportunities for  
12 all to take part in this cultural experience; and

13 WHEREAS, The current makeup of the Washington State Legislature  
14 is the most diverse in our state's history, and therefore a better  
15 reflection of the people it serves; and

16 WHEREAS, This is a time to reflect on our successes and  
17 challenges from the past, to learn from those experiences, and create  
18 new goals and objectives for the coming year; and

19 WHEREAS, We commend this Lunar New Year tradition of familial  
20 reunion, and hope to reflect these practices as a unified legislative  
21 body; and

22 WHEREAS, In observation of this Lunar New Year, we recognize this  
23 year as the Year of the Pig, an animal sign characterized by honesty,

1 sincerity, and peace-loving qualities that we hope our chamber will  
2 strive to emulate;

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives  
4 commemorate the many contributions of Washington state's Asian  
5 American people and communities through recognition of the Lunar New  
6 Year.
