HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 2022-4640, by Representatives Cody, Bronoske, Simmons, Harris, and Macri

1 WHEREAS, Thyroid Eye Disease (TED) is a serious, progressive, and 2 rare autoimmune condition in which the body's immune system 3 mistakenly attacks healthy muscle and fat tissue behind the eye, 4 causing inflammation and scar tissue to form; and

5 WHEREAS, People living with TED often have debilitating symptoms 6 of eye bulging, double vision, blurred vision, and pain and facial 7 disfigurement, which, in severe cases, can lead to blindness; and

8 WHEREAS, People living with TED often experience long-term 9 impacts on functional, psychosocial, and economic burdens, including 10 the inability to work or perform activities of daily living; and

11 WHEREAS, The exact underlying process by which TED occurs is not 12 fully understood and TED is a serious, vision threatening condition 13 that can get worse over time; and

14 WHEREAS, TED is a rare disease and is estimated to have a 15 prevalence of 16 per 100,000 women in the general population, and 2.9 16 per 100,000 men in the general population; and

WHEREAS, A diagnosis of TED is based upon identification of characteristic symptoms, a detailed patient history, a thorough clinical evaluation, and a variety of specialized tests; and

20 WHEREAS, There is a genetic component to the condition and people 21 who have a family member with the disease or a family member with an 22 autoimmune disease are at a greater risk of developing the condition; 23 and WHEREAS, TED Awareness Week has been established through a
collaboration among advocacy organizations, including the Autoimmune
Association and Prevent Blindness; and

WHEREAS, The patient groups are engaged in disease awareness and patient support and the third week of November 2022, is recognized as Thyroid Eye Disease Week;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives
recognize the third week of November 2022, as TED Awareness Week.

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
