

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 2018-4666, by Representative Vick

1 WHEREAS, It is the policy of the Washington State House of
2 Representatives to recognize excellence in every field of endeavor;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, For the first time in school history, the Hockinson High
5 School Hawks are the 2017 2A Football State Champions; and

6 WHEREAS, The Hockinson Hawks completed an undefeated season with
7 a record of 14-0; and

8 WHEREAS, The Hockinson Hawks overcame Tumwater High School in the
9 state championship at the Tacoma Dome on December 2, 2017, by a final
10 score of 35 to 22; and

11 WHEREAS, The Hockinson Hawks beat West Valley High School in the
12 semifinals 53 to 30; and

13 WHEREAS, The Hockinson Hawks scored an astonishing 633 points
14 throughout the season; and

15 WHEREAS, The Hockinson Hawks defense dominated the season by only
16 allowing 13 points per game; and

17 WHEREAS, The Hockinson Hawks Head Coach Rick Steele mentored and
18 coached these young men; and

19 WHEREAS, The Hockinson Hawks starting quarterback Canon Racanelli
20 was named the 2A Football Player of the Year; and

21 WHEREAS, The Hockinson Hawks wide receiver Sawyer Racanelli,
22 offensive lineman Kordell Johnson, defensive lineman Kyle Brabec, and

1 linebacker Colton Wheeler were named members of the 2A First Team for
2 football in the state of Washington; and

3 WHEREAS, The Hockinson Hawks defensive back Matt Henry was named
4 Honorable Mention for football in the state of Washington;

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That on this day the Washington
6 State House of Representatives congratulate the Hockinson High School
7 football team on their state championship and their fans, supportive
8 alumni, and the entire Hockinson community for this remarkable
9 accomplishment; and

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be
11 immediately transmitted by the Chief Clerk of the House of
12 Representatives to the Hockinson High School Hawks football team and
13 to Head Coach Rick Steele.
